



Getting to the AUT City Campus:

The AUT City Campus is a 15-minute walk from the Britomart train station and the downtown ferry terminal, with public bus stops near the campus.

Physical location Wellesley ST East. Off Queen ST. There are many option to get into the CBD and this cover is off in the <u>Auckland Transport network</u>.

In general there is a not lot of available parking around the streets of the City Campus, but there are parking buildings nearby, <u>Auckland City Parking by AT</u> the best and closest AT park to AUT is the CIVIC car park near the Aotea Centre and <u>Wilsons Parking</u>. NOTE:

If Driving to the City Campus, be mindful of the Queen St one way system, it is designed for buses' taxis' and Ubers. There is a \$150 fine if you get caught on the cameras that patrol the area between the bottom of Queen St and the Wellesley intersection. If using your GPS, make sure it is updated or is using Google and you are driving it will redirect you away from Queen St. Even though there are lots of signage stating the road is only for these vehicles, there is no mention of the associated fine.
