


How to find AUT



Getting to the AUT City Campus:

The AUT City Campus is a 15-minute walk from the Britomart train station and the downtown ferry terminal, with public bus stops near the campus.

Physical location Wellesley ST East, off Queen St.

In general there is a not a lot of available parking around the streets of the City Campus, but there are parking buildings nearby. Check out <u>Auckland City Parking by AT</u>. The closest AT park to AUT is the CIVIC car park near the Aotea Centre and <u>Wilsons Parking</u>. There are other Wilsons car parks around the City Centre. <u>Click here</u> to see more options.

Campervans: There aren't many large parking spaces in the Auckland CBD. The best option is to overnight in a camping ground such as Takapuna Motor Camp and use the <u>AT Bus system</u> to the CBD. You can also freedom camp but most of these sites are situated some distance from the bus routes.

NOTE:

If driving to the City Campus, be mindful of the Queen St one way system. It is designed for buses, taxis and Ubers. There is a \$150 fine if you get caught on the cameras that patrol the area between the bottom of Queen St and the Wellesley intersection. If using your GPS, make sure it is updated or is using Google as you will then be redirected away from Queen St. Even though there is a lot of signage stating the road is only for these vehicles, there is no mention of the associated fine.
